A complex, concentrated example of Pouilly Fumé with well balanced, crisp gooseberry and blackcurrant leaf fruit overlaid with hints of citrus and mineral.

No tricks here, just a youthful and exquisite Sauvignon Blanc with prominent asparagus, mature peach and exotic fruit notes on the nose.

The nose shows aromatic white flowers mixed with citrus notes as well as pear and pineapple.

Riesling, Mount Edward, Central Otago, New Zealand

A vibrant aroma of apple blossom and orange zest with a hint of ginger; leads to a bracingly fresh palate of apple and lime.

Stone Soil Select Malbec, Paraje Altamira, Uco Valley, Argentina <i>Silky texture with a racy flash of acidity on the finish. Excellent plum fruit, herbal hints and wonderful structure with fig flavours on the long finish.</i>	£49.00
Cabernet Sauvignon, Napa Valley, Paul Hobbs, California, USA <i>The generous and savoury palate excites with black fig, dark chocolate, tobacco leaf and graphite.</i>	£280.00
