ENGLISH BREAKFAST

A traditionally 'English' tea prepared from the best Indian and Ceylon teas, enjoyed by guests from all across the world. This refreshing, strong cup of tea is best enjoyed with a splash of milk.

EARL GREY

The Gillard's blend of this world-famous tea is exclusive & hand blended using a selection of finest Chinese Teas, and carefully infused with oil of bergamot orange. Named after Charles II, Earl Grey, British Prime Minister 1830-1834 who was reputedly given some tea flavoured with bergamot-probably a diplomatic gift.

ROSEATE BLEND

Inspired by a 100 year old recipe, a blend of the most superior Darjeeling and Assam teas, this is meant for a discerning tea lover.

BATH CITY BLEND

Developed in 1888 to suit the particularly hard water of the city of Bath, this makes a superb pot of tea where water has a high lime content.

RUSSIAN CARAVAN

A unique blend of fine Chinese teas, the Russian Caravan is a multi-layered brew that is aromatic, full bodied and has a sweet, malty and smoky taste.

JANE AUSTEN BLEND

Named in honour of the world-famous novelist, a resident of Bath and a reputed tea-lover, the Gillards of Bath, a long standing blend recreates three fine Chinese teas into a delicate tea that was enjoyed throughout the 18th century.

Best served without milk.

LADY WHISTLEDOWN

An extraordinary blend of the finest black tea, rose petals, rosehip and blackberry leaves, this tea has a delicious & wonderfully floral note, reminiscent of an English rose garden.

GINGER AND LEMONGRASS

Fruity, fresh lemongrass and spicy ginger blend perfectly with liquorice root to give an extra touch of finesse. This herb tea is not spicy, but has a natural sweetness because of the added liquorice

SENCHA

Sencha, which means steamed tea, is one of the best-known green tea varieties.

Soft and mild with sweet notes.

GUNPOWDER GREEN AND MINT

Probably the most popular green tea with a strong flavour and aroma with a hint of mint, this tea acquired its name from its similarity in appearance to the old-fashioned gunpowder.
