

CHAMPAGNE AND SPARKLING WINE

125ml/Bottle

La Vita Sociale Prosecco, Spumante, Veneto, Italy

£7.95/£38.00

Crisp and delicious with aromatic apple and pear aromas on the nose followed by a crisp palate of succulent fruits. Gently foamy, just off dry and possesses an enticing bright finish.

Stars Brut Reserva Cava, Perelada, Spain

£8.50/£45.00

Bright and clean. Its generous stream of fine bubbles forms a perfect crown. On the nose it is clean, with fruity notes and marked ageing notes. Dry, smooth and complex in the mouth, it has superb balance.

Moët & Chandon Brut Imperial, Champagne, France

£75.00

Moët Impérial is the House's iconic champagne. Created in 1869, it embodies Moët & Chandon's unique style, a style distinguished by its bright fruitiness, its seductive palate and its elegant maturity.

Moët Rose Imperial, Champagne, France

£88 00

Rosé Impérial is a spontaneous, radiant, romantic expression of the Moët & Chandon style. A lively, intense bouquet of red fruits, wild strawberry, raspberry, cherry with a hint of pepper.

Roebuck Classic Cuvée, Roebuck Estates, Sussex, England

£110.95

Rich, yet pale lemon in colour. Notes of baked apples and citrus fruits are layered with a toasty richness and hint of hazelnut. Delicate bubbles linger on the palate leading to a long, beautifully balanced finish.

Roebuck Rosé de Noirs, Roebuck Estates, Sussex, England

£125.00

Delicate rose-pink in colour with fragrant aromas of ripe strawberries, raspberries and white peach. An expressive palate displaying deliciously ripe notes of red berry fruits, honeysuckle and a hint of almond. Beautifully balanced with a bright seam of acidity, a fine persistent mousse and a long, yet elegant finish.

Roebuck Blanc De Noirs, Roebuck Estates, Sussex, England

£140.00

Attractive golden copper hue. Delightful bouquet of ripe stone and citrus fruits lifted by floral notes. Baked apples on the palate are layered with complex notes of toasted almonds, characteristic of a generous bottle-ageing. A rich, yet beautifully balanced wine with delicate bubbles, a silky texture and a long-lingering finish.

Trebbiano, Terre Allegre, Veneto, Italy

£7 50/£2 50/£28 00

Yellow in colour, this light, crisp white has fresh zesty, citrus flavours, fruity notes and a clean refreshing finish.

Pinot Grigio, Casa Defra, Delle Venezie, Italy

£7.95/£11.00/£32.00

Rich plum and earthy tones with a hint of toasty oak on the nose. The palate has a lovely, sweet entry, which builds in the mouth, supported by ripe and silky fruit and oak tannins.

Viognier, Mont Rocher, Vieilles Vignes, Languedoc-Roussillon, France £9.50/£13.50/£40.00 A delightful honeysuckle and apricot aroma, with rich, fruity palate that is somehow still dry, tangy and refreshing.

Chardonnay, Cartlidge and Browne, California, USA

£60.00

Burgundian in style with elegant mineral complexity combined with the slightest caramel and brown sugar notes. Aromas of green apples & honeysuckle and flavours of pear, melon and light citrus with aromatics of straw, lemon and oak tones of sweet caramel and hazelnut.

Albariño, Lagar de Bouza, Bouza do Rei, Galicia, Spain

£55.00

Aromas of ripe citrus fruit, crushed flowers and underlying minerality give way to a fresh, crisp palate of lemon zest, fresh lime, stone fruits and notes of flint soil.

Sauvignon Blanc, Mayfly, Marlborough, New Zealand

£11.00/15.50/45.00

A youthful and exquisite Sauvignon Blanc with an intensely aromatic nose of grapefruit, passionfruit, lime and ginger. The palate is crisp, textural and citrus laced followed by hints of lime cordial, grapefruit and lychee. Long and intense on the finish.

Gavi di Gavi, Tenuta Olim Bauda, Piedmont, Italy

£60.00

A fine bouquet of good intensity and persistence with floral notes, Olim Bauda's Gavi di Gavi is fresh, soft, harmonious and has a delightful finish.

Sancerre Blanc, Domaine Jean- Paul Picard, Loire, France

£70.00

An expressive nose of exotic fruit and intense aromas of zesty citrus, which follows through to the palate, and is vibrant and finely textured.

Chablis, Vau-ligneau, Domaine Michaut Freres, Burgundy, France

£96.00

A vivid yellow with a hint of green. A mineral and fruity wine, with a remarkable length in the mouth.

- ROSE WINE

Tempranillo, Finca Manzanos, Bodegas Manzanos, Rioja, Spain £7.50/£10.50/£28.00 Intense cherry red colour, ripe black and red fruits, spices, liquorice and chocolate aroma. Round and well-balanced with fruity notes.

Montepulciano d'Abruzzo, Feudo Antico, Abruzzo, Italy £7.95/£11.00/£32.00 Small red berry fruits, wild cherry, violets, delicate and spicy. Full bodied, well-structured with soft and balanced tannins.

Grenache Noir, Felicette, Terres Fidèles, Languedoc-Roussillon, France £8.50/£12.50/£36.00 Bright red colour with purplish tones. A 'booster' powered nose of violets and red fruits. The Grenache launches fruit flavours of raspberry and plum. Medium-bodied on the palate, soft and juicy.

Pinot Noir, Nostros Reserva, Indómita, Casablanca, Chile £8.50/£12.50/£36.00 Intense, deep colour. Aromas of red and black wild berries, truffle, paprika, pepper and clove. The round and silky body characteristic of ripe Pinot Noir offers a pleasant, persistent and full experience.

Shiraz, Cunning Plan, McLaren Vale, Thistledown, Australia £60.00 Great depth of ripe plum and blackberry fruit flavours. A full bodied wine with a succulent palate, lively spices and fine velvety tannins.

Malbec, Felino, Viña Cobos, Mendoza, Argentina £12.25/£17.00/£55.00 Bright and deep purple colour. Aromas of black fruit reminiscent of fresh plum mixed with graphite notes. On the palate, the wine is balanced and energetic, with sweet and round tannins and a long finish.

Bordeaux, Château Jaron, Bordeaux, France

£45.00

Abundant blackcurrant intensity, with finesse and rounded, almost voluptuous tannins. Yet the most delightful characteristic is the incredible freshness and lift on the finish. Beautifully balanced.

Chianti Classico, Riecine, Tuscany, Italy

£80.00

Pale crimson red colour. This has an exciting nose and bright acidity. Succulent, red fruit with fine, powerful tannins. This Sangiovese has taken on a Pinot Noir like guise.

Barolo, Cascina Adelaide, Piedmont, Italy

£130.00

A magnificent Barolo, with aromas of orange skin, plums and tobacco leaves. Tannins are vibrant and acidity is plentiful making this a wine with excellent ageing potential.
